

Configuring Screen saver with Password resume protect – Widows XP

1. **Right click** on anywhere of *Desktop*, then a menu pops up
2. Select **Properties** on the bottom of the menu, a **Display Properties** window shows up
3. Click on **Screen Saver** tab, set **Wait minutes** to **15**, and make sure the box “**on resume, password protect**” is **checked**
4. Click **OK** to finish the setup

Configuring Screen saver with Password resume protect – Vista

1. **Right click** on anywhere of *Desktop*, then a menu pops up
2. Select **Personalize** on the bottom of the menu, a window shows up
3. Click **Screen Saver** from the list items, set **Wait minutes** to **15**, and make sure the box “**on resume, password protect**” is **checked**
4. Click **OK** to finish the setup

Configuring Screen saver with Password resume protect – OS 10.3

1. Select “**System Preferences...**” on the menu, a window pops up
2. Select “**Desktop & Screen Saver**” icon on the top row of Personal setting, a new window shows up
3. Select **Screen Saver** tab, and at the bottom left window, slide the time bar for **Start screen saver to 15 minutes**. Select **Show All** on the top of the window back to **System Preferences...**
4. Select the **Security** icon, In the Security window under the **General** tab place a check mark in the box for “**Require password to wake this computer from sleep or screensaver**”.
5. Place a check mark in the box for “**Disable Automatic Login**”
6. Close the window to finish the setting

Configuring Screen saver with Password resume protect – OS 10.4

1. Select “**System Preferences...**” on the menu, a window pops up
2. Select “**Desktop & Screen Saver**” icon on the top row of Personal setting, a new window shows up

3. Select **Screen Saver** tab, and at the bottom left window, slide the time bar for **Start screen saver to 15 minutes**. Select **Show All** on the top of the window back to **System Preferences...**
4. Select the **Security** icon, In the Security window under the **General** tab place a check mark in the box for “**Require password to wake this computer from sleep or screensaver**”.
5. Place a check mark in the box for “**Disable Automatic Login**”
6. Close the window to finish the setting
