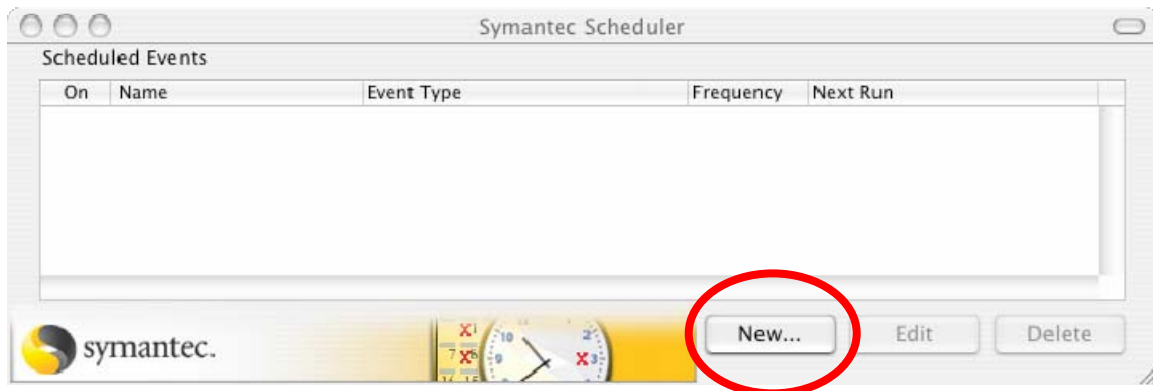

Scheduling Virus Definition Updates for Mac OS X

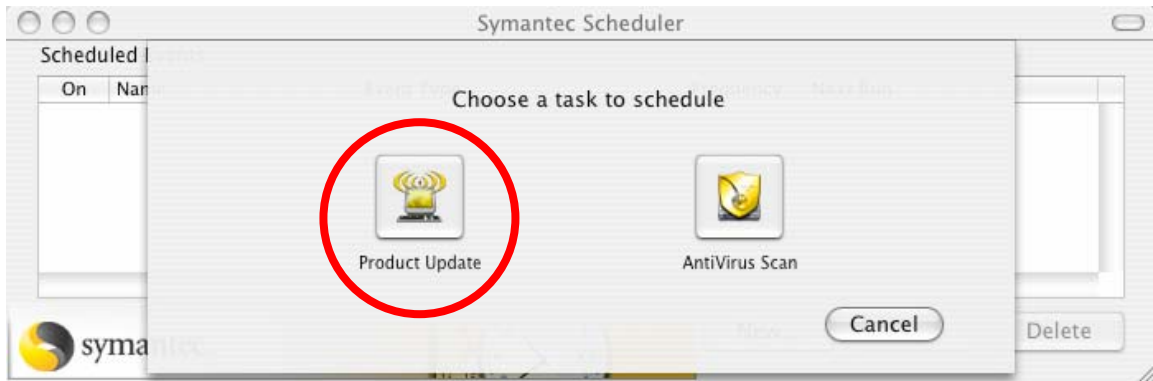
To keep a computer virus free it is important to keep virus definitions up-to-date. To schedule NAV to automatically update the definitions do the following:



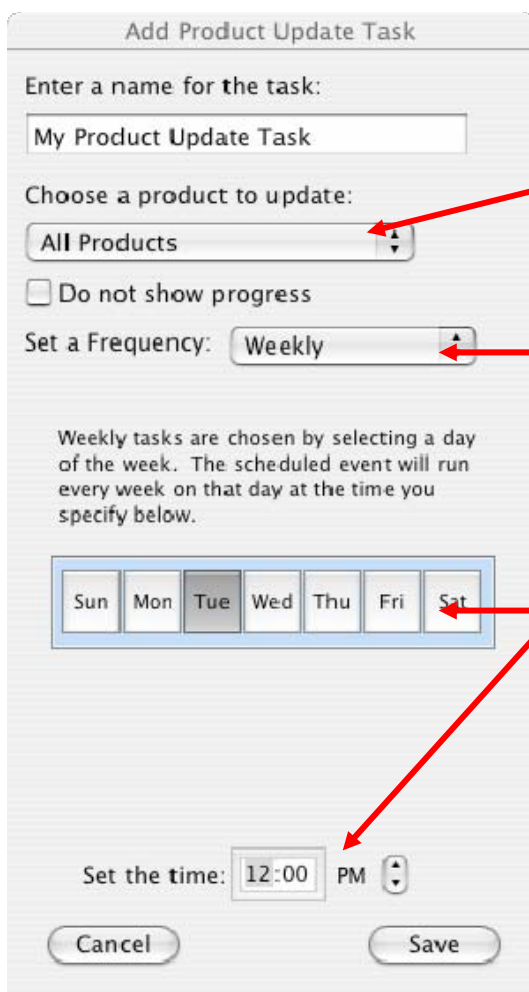
Start by clicking on the gold/black mobius shield in the menu bar at the top right corner of the screen. In the shortcut menu, choose "Norton Antivirus," then "Live Update," then "Open Symantec Scheduler." The Symantec Scheduler window will then open.



Click on the "New..." button...



Then choose the "Product Update" option.



The Add Product Update Task box should appear (left).

Under "Choose a product to update," select "All Products" from the drop-down list.

Set the frequency to "Weekly."

Select a day and a time that works best for your schedule. (We suggest you schedule the update during your lunch break, or when your computer would still be running and the update does not interfere with your work.)

Click "Save."

When finished, go to Symantec Scheduler in the menu bar and select Quit.
